What if it didn't have to be this way?

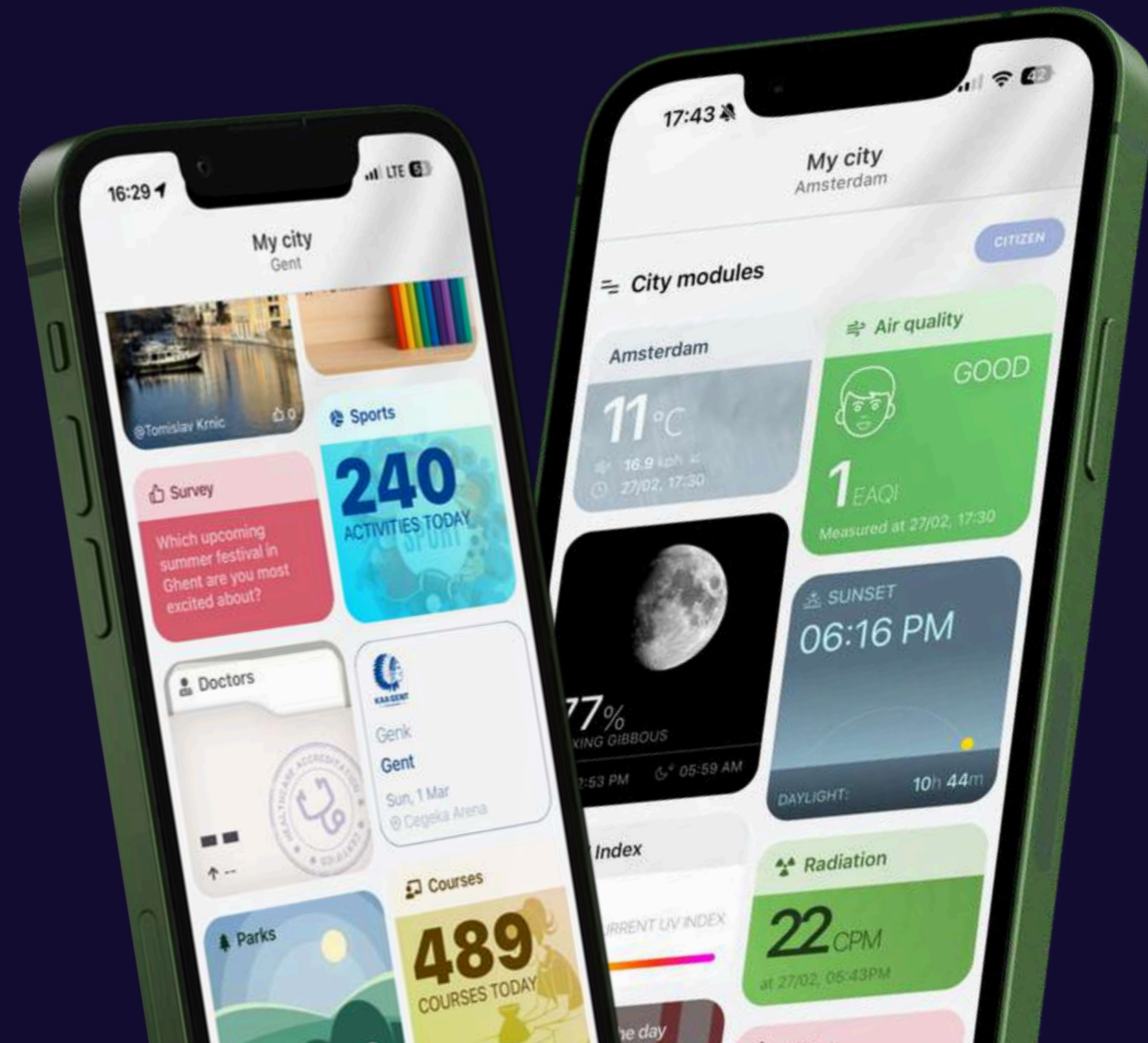
Meet CityX

The city changes. The app stays the same.



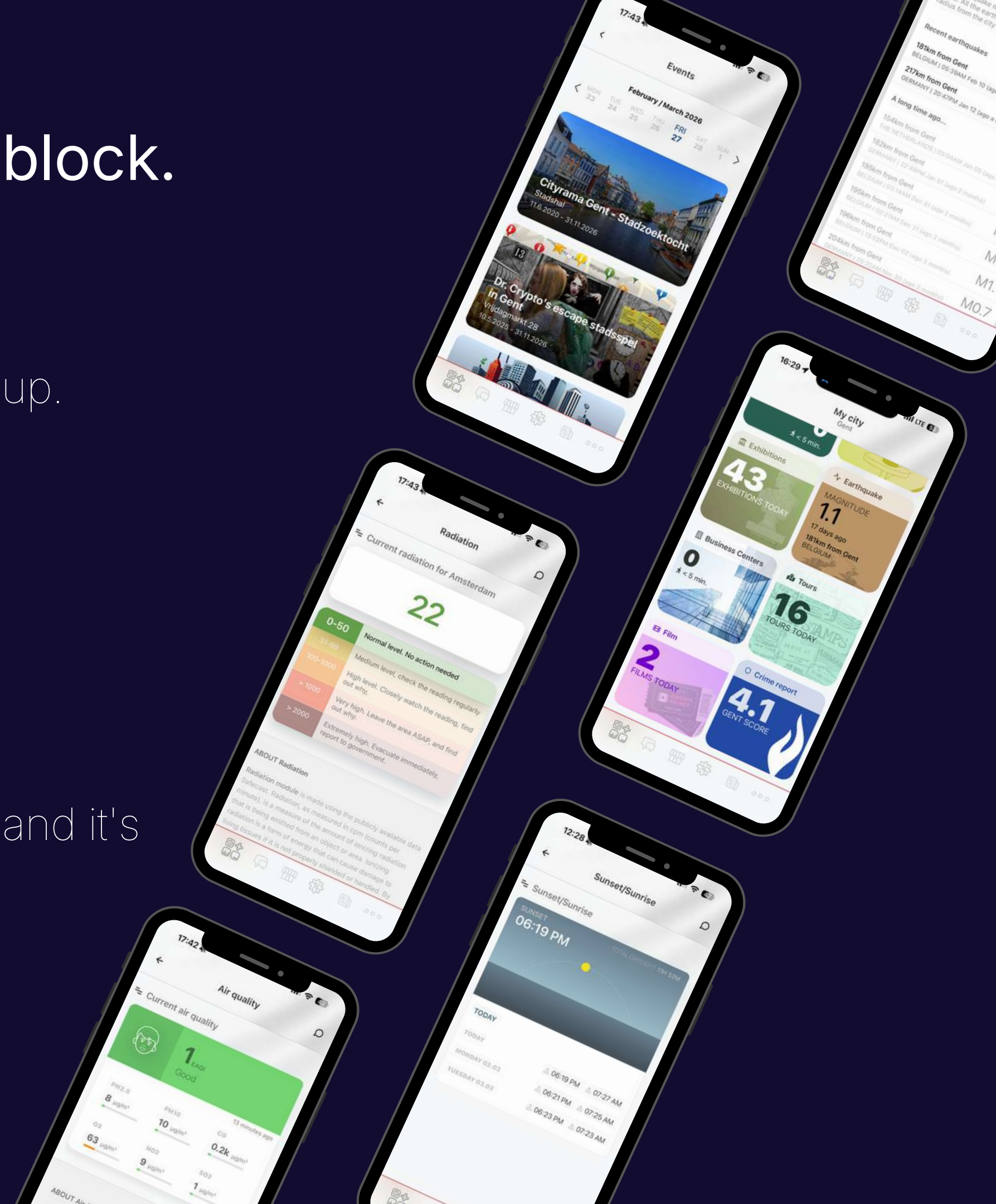
Everything in your city is a building block.

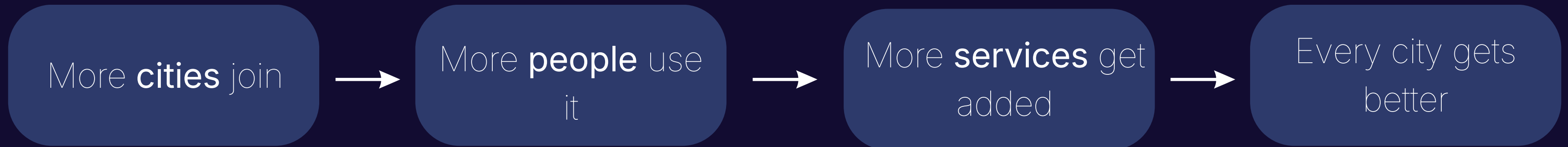
